Effective 01 November 2025 all bid adverts, bidding documents, bid opening reports, bid evaluation executive summaries, notice of selection of awards, notice of awards/cancellations and any other information related to the procurement process will be accessible on the e-GP. We therefore encourage all interested parties to familiarize themselves with the e-GP in order to ensure continued access to our procurement opportunities.

Dear Accounting Officers,

SUBJECT: DIRECTIVE IN TERMS OF SECTION 73: MANDATORY USAGE OF ELECTRONIC GOVERNMENT (e-GP) PORTAL BY ALL PUBLIC ENTITIES.

- 1. The Government of the Republic of Namibia implemented phase 1 of the e-GP system on 1 April 2022. To facilitate this, the Procurement Policy Unit issued a letter dated 29 March 2022, urging all public entities to use the *e-GP Portal effective from 1st April 2022*.
- 2. However, we have observed that many public entities are not yet fully utilising the e-GP Portal. This limited utilisation of the system undermines the full realisation of the e-GP system's intended benefits.
- 3. This directive serves as an urgent reminder for all Accounting Officers to immediately commence using the e-GP portal. The implementation of the e-GP system is crucial for restoring confidence in the public procurement system by reducing opportunities for corruption, promotion of transparency and operational efficiency.
- 4. Henceforth, all Public Entities are directed to upload/ capture the following information/documents on the e-GP portal.
 - Approved Annual Procurement Plans (APPs),
 - Publish Bid Adverts
 - Publish Bidding Documents,
 - Bid Opening Report,
 - Bid Evaluation Executive Summary,
 - Notice of Selection of Award
 - Notice of Award/ Cancellation, and
 - Any other information related to the procurement process completed.

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- 5. Public Entities requiring training on the E-GP portal are urged to contact Mr. Willibarth Haraseb at email: Willibarth Haraseb@mfpe.gov.na or by phone at (+264 61) 209 9406 without delay to schedule training and commence using the e-GP portal.
- 6. Public entities already using the E-GP Portal are acknowledged.
