The Kavango East Regional Council reserves the right:

- (a) Have a valid company Registration Certificate;
- (b) Have an original valid good Standing Tax Certificate;
- (c) Have an original valid good Standing Social Security Certificate;
- (d) Have a valid certified copy of Affirmative Action Compliance Certificate, proof from Employment Equity Commissioner that bidder is not a relevant employer, or exemption issued in terms of Section 42 of the Affirmative Action Act, 1998;
- (e) Submit signed Bid-securing Declaration.

Quotations should be submitted at the constituencies where the training is going to take place not later than 28 October 2025 at 11:00 am. Late quotations will be rejected.

Quotations shall cover all costs of labour, materials, equipment, overheads, profits and all associated costs for performing the services, and shall include all duties.
